HOMEWORK AND LATE WORK POLICY

Students are expected and encouraged to complete assignments in order to extend and reinforce classroom instruction and to prepare for formal assessment. Pursuant to that objective, students may be allowed to turn in assignments up to the date of the formal or summative assessment for the material. Each teacher will establish a progressive grading policy for late work. After the formal assessment, teachers are under no obligation to allow late work for that material to be submitted. Students need to read the syllabus for each class to understand course policy for assignments and grading. Dual enrollment courses may defer to the grading guidelines of the corresponding college or university, which will be indicated on the class syllabus.

MAKE-UP WORK - EXCUSED ABSENCES

The student is responsible for obtaining all make-up work and for making appointments to meet with teachers to make-up tests, labs, etc. Students are expected to make up all work missed as the result of an absence. They will be allowed two (2) days for the first day missed and one (1) day for each consecutive day absent beyond the first unless other arrangements are made with the individual teachers. Advance make-up is required (unless other arrangements are made with the classroom teacher) when the absence is due to a regularly scheduled school sponsored activity and may be required on prearranged absences authorized by the principal.
