- There are scholarships that require the ACT to be taken, in order to apply.
- Students can make yourself visible to colleges and scholarship agencies across the country by taking the ACT.
- Career Planning
 - Career and Navigation. Provides an Indicator of progress toward the National Career Readiness Certificate that estimates students' progress toward the ACT[®] National Career Readiness Certificate[®] (NCRC[®])¹. Also, the ACT provides career planning resources.

Benefits to taking the WorkKeys:

- Measures the workplace skills that can affect your job performance
 - Applied Mathematics
 - Measures critical thinking, mathematical reasoning, and problem-solving techniques for situations that occur in the workplace.
 - Graphic Literacy
 - Measures skills that individuals use when they read and comprehend graphical materials to solve work-related problems. (charts, graphs, diagrams, etc)
 - Workplace Documents
 - Measures skills that individuals use when they read workplace documents and use that information to make job-related decisions and solve problems. (includes: messages, emails, letters, directions, signs, bulletins, policies, regulations, etc)
