Welcome to the Greenbush Virtual Academy (GVA) High School Program! We are excited you are interested in this program and we hope this information will be useful in your decision process to enroll your student in GVA. The GVA High School curriculum is provided by Edgenuity and EDynamic Learning. Your student's teachers will be highly qualified Kansas certified teachers residing in Kansas who will be available to tutor and facilitate your student's journey through their coursework.

The GVA High School curriculum is available for students in 9th through 12th grade. You will be amazed by the creative and engaging experiences offered through our interactive curriculum that includes Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies and many elective options that will interest your student.

Your student's teachers and Academic Coach will be available to also help you and will be an invaluable resource for providing assistance and guidance in ways to help your student be more successful. Your student's Academic Coach and teachers will work as a team to help guide your student as they plan for their life after High School and assist them with their Individual Plans of Study (IPS).

In order to have a successful student experience, we recommend the parent/guardian monitor their student's progress closely. You will find a Progress Bar in each course. It shows your student's current progress and will show if a student is on track, ahead, or falling behind. The Course Map will display the activities your student needs to complete each day to stay on track to finish on schedule. You can request an emailed progress report daily or weekly and your student's teachers will contact you and your student often to provide feedback. Many assignments can be re-submitted based on teacher feedback to strengthen your student's mastery and to improve their score.

What online tools are available to help your student with lesson content? In their lessons your student will find many tools such as the ability to take digital notes, use an online glossary, and even read transcripts of the video instruction to ensure they don't miss key information. There are also subject-specific online tools such as calculators, formula sheets, and the periodic table. Your student will be able to access the text translation tool if needed where the text can be translated into one of over 60 languages. They can also highlight text and have it read aloud to them. Your student will have access to several reports that are helpful for staying on track and view their progress. They will have access to the Course Report, which serves as an assignment calendar as well as showing grades, and their Attendance Log, which keeps track of daily activities and time online.
