- Minimum three years successful experience in PreK-12 teaching required
- Minimum five years of outstanding PreK-12 classroom teaching experience preferred

General Duties and Requirements

- Demonstrates a comprehensive understanding of Multi-Tier System of Supports, the role of intervention, and the role of an interventionist
- Able to identify and target specific instruction for students based on data
- Incorporates curricular revisions and new programs into instruction
- Provides intervention support for students and staff
- Provides support for parents to assist students at home
- Facilitates assessments as needed
- Collaborates with other building and district staff members
- Provides professional learning for staff
- Demonstrates effective presentation skills and styles, which reflect curricular objectives
- Uses reinforcement to influence positive behavior
- Creates a physical environment conducive to learning
- Creates an emotional atmosphere conducive to learning
- Maintains a positive attitude and interact positively with other staff members and students
- Works to complete building, district, and board of education goals
- Prepares a variety of manual and electronic documents, files and records (e.g. professional development materials, purchase orders, student contact logs, etc.)
